

INFORMATION NOTE
on the Activities Implemented by the Economic Department
of the Academy of Justice of the Republic of Uzbekistan in 2025–2026

The Economic Department of the Academy of Justice of the Republic of Uzbekistan carried out systematic activities aimed at strengthening the material and technical base of the Academy, maintaining and renovating buildings and facilities, creating comfortable working and educational conditions, ensuring sanitary and hygienic standards, and providing logistical support for national and international events held at the Academy. These activities were implemented in accordance with the responsibilities defined in the Regulation on the Economic Department.

During 2025–2026, a number of practical measures were undertaken to maintain the Academy’s buildings and premises in line with modern standards, improve the educational environment, and ensure comfortable conditions for trainees, faculty members, and staff.

First of all, special attention was given to repair, landscaping, and improving the overall appearance of the Academy’s main building and surrounding territory. Renovation works were carried out in both interior and exterior areas of the building, including refurbishment of walls and ceilings in several premises, painting, improvement of flooring, and maintenance of doors and windows. Continuous efforts were also made to improve sanitary conditions, maintain green areas, ensure cleanliness of the courtyard, and enhance the external aesthetic appearance of the Academy premises.

In addition, renovation works were undertaken in the offices, classrooms, and other facilities located on the fourth floor allocated to the Academy. These premises were prepared for use in accordance with modern educational requirements, with measures implemented to improve the internal environment, optimize lighting systems, upgrade electrical supply, and ensure functional and comfortable learning and working spaces. Particular attention was paid to creating a favorable environment for the effective organization of the educational process.

To support the effective organization of educational activities, classrooms and offices were equipped with furniture and necessary facilities. In particular, modern educational furniture, desks, chairs, cabinets, and office furniture for meeting and working spaces were gradually procured and installed. Special attention was also devoted to the repair and maintenance of existing furniture and inventory, their efficient and economical use, and the proper accounting and safeguarding of material assets.

During 2025–2026, renovation works were also carried out in sanitary facilities with the objective of improving sanitary and hygienic conditions within the

Academy. In particular, sanitation facilities were repaired, water supply and sewage systems were improved, essential sanitary equipment was installed, and cleaning and hygiene materials were provided. These measures contributed to creating decent sanitary conditions for Academy staff, trainees, and visitors.

The Economic Department also provided practical support in organizing national and international events held at the Academy. This included preparing classrooms and meeting halls for international forums, roundtable discussions, seminars, conferences, and meetings involving foreign guests, as well as ensuring the necessary technical and logistical arrangements. During such events, the Department systematically provided drinking water, napkins, paper products, stationery, and other necessary supplies, thereby contributing to the high organizational quality and smooth conduct of the events.

Furthermore, continuous efforts were undertaken to ensure the uninterrupted operation of electricity, water supply, heating, and sewage systems at the Academy, promptly eliminate technical malfunctions, comply with fire safety requirements, and ensure occupational safety and security measures. Systematic control was maintained over the rational use of fuel and energy resources, efficient use of material resources, and cleanliness and orderliness in offices and common-use areas.

As a result of the work carried out by the Economic Department, the Academy succeeded in creating the necessary material, technical, and organizational conditions for the effective implementation of educational activities, ensuring decent working and learning conditions for faculty, trainees, and staff, and facilitating the successful organization of international cooperation events at a high level.

In the future, further efforts are planned to strengthen the Academy's material and technical base, modernize buildings and classrooms, introduce energy-saving and digital management solutions, further improve sanitary and aesthetic conditions, and enhance the quality of logistical support provided for international events.
